QUALIFICATIONS:

- ✓ Promotes and enhances the image of a GI nurse in his/her hospital or the community
- ✓ Participates in professional organizations and National activities for CSGNA
- ✓ Demonstrates commitment to continuing education
- ✓ Acts as a role model and mentor
- ✓ Encourages certification among peers
- ✓ Does volunteer work
- ✓ Contributes to improving quality of care of patients and their families
- ✓ Published – article, abstract or editorial in a journal (preferred)
- ✓ Current member of CSGNA
- ✓ Completion of specialty certification
- ✓ Author or co-author of a book (preferred)
- ✓ Completion of Bachelor's degree
- ✓ Presented or co-presented at a conference
- ✓ Completion of Masters degree (preferred)
- ✓ Completion of a post-graduate Nursing Certificate
- ✓ Presented at a hospital in-service (oral or poster)
- ✓ Unit contribution – has written policies and procedures
- ✓ Recipient of a recognized Provincial, National or International Award
- ✓ CSGNA Chapter member who actively supports and attends CSGNA functions

The Nominee must be nominated by at least two nominators who must submit a written statement to support the nomination.

All submissions will be evaluated by the Awards and Research Committee comprised of the Director of Awards and Research, President and President Elect. Where there is a conflict of interest another board member will be engaged to assist in the decisions. All decisions of the committee are final.
