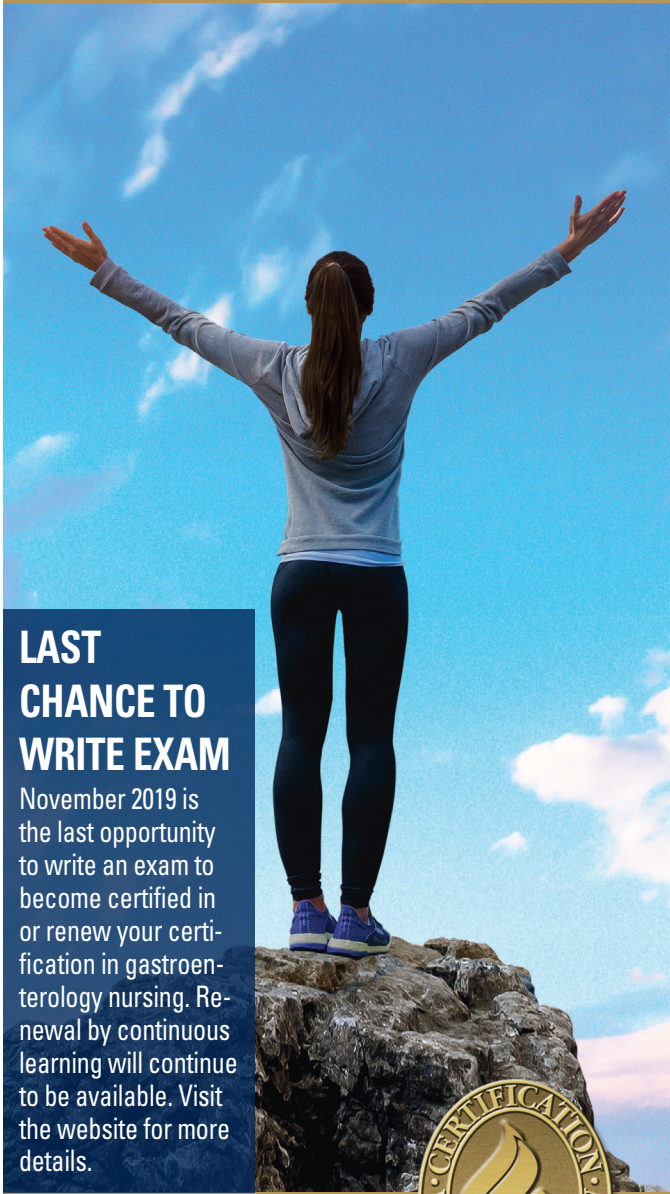

Application window to write or renew by exam	➤	June 3 – September 12
Exam window	➤	November 1 – 15
Deadline to renew by continuous learning	➤	November 1
Apply by June 1 to save 10% on your renewal fee		

Note: Once CNA certified, your CGN(C) credential is valid for a five-year term.
